



Caribou recovery

The Ecological Society of America (ESA) has released a detailed study on caribou recovery in British Columbia providing evidence that wolf culling and maternal penning for birthing caribou has been successful in increasing the caribou population but notes this is a "band-aid measure" which must be matched with extensive habitat restoration for long term survival of the caribou.
